



## Greenland—“Paid in Full”

## **AMENDMENT TWENTY-EIGHT United States Constitution**

[Section 1] All members of Congress and all members of the Executive Branch of the United States including the President, shall strive to persuade the indigenous people of Greenland to agree to become one of the Several States of the United States.

[Section 2] When Greenland shall become one of the Several States of the United States, all of the indigenous people in Greenland shall be citizens of the United States and shall enjoy all of the privileges and immunities of United States citizenship. No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge or deny any of the indigenous people of Greenland their life, liberty or property without due process of law and equal protection of the laws.

[Section 3] After the indigenous people of Greenland have become citizens of the United States, all taxes generated in Greenland, all natural resources developed in Greenland, and all economic wealth arising from Greenland, shall

**first** be applied as a **highest priority** to provide for the education, full employment, full health care, protection and prosperity of the indigenous people in Greenland.

[Section 4] The term of office of the President of the United States shall be extended and shall continue without interruption so long as the President is making substantial progress toward accomplishing and achieving the goal of making Greenland one of the Several States of the United States.

[Section 5] The Congress shall enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this Amendment.
